CLASS INFORMATION

Participating in the recital is a lot of fun, but is also a commitment. Attendance each week in class is <u>very</u> important for your child to learn the technique, choreography and the group formations.

Each class is learning a different routine for the recital and make-up classes will not be available.

January will focus on technique / February-June will focus on technique and learning/perfecting their recital routine.

Recital Fees are in addition to the monthly tuition (January - June 15th).

CLASS PICTURES

Each class will have their own picture day (in costume) during their regularly scheduled class time, May 28th - June 3rd.

Miss Tawny will take a class photo and email a copy to parents after the recital.

One parent may come with their dancer to take individual photos after the class picture has been completed.

RECITAL FEE

With your total costs is a recital fee of \$28 per student. This includes:

Recital trophy, emailed copy of the music, digital copy of the class photo, shipping/handling/alteration of costumes (costumes are also steamed and hung in clear garment bags for you), program/ticket printing costs, etc.

SHOES

Your child will need to have specific dance shoes for each class they take. Your instructor will announce what style/color shoes your child will be needing after the costumes have been ordered.

Please do not purchase new shoes before our announcement.

COSTUMES & TIGHTS

X-small child - large child = \$49 X-large child - large adult = \$55 Combo Classes = \$87 child / \$92 adult

Miss Tawny will measure your child the first week of classes. <u>Costumes cannot be ordered without measurements.</u>

Costume orders will be placed on January 13th. A costume will not be ordered without a payment.

There will be a shipping/handling charge of \$15-20 per costume if payment is received after January 13th, however, we cannot guarantee that we will still be able to order the costume after this date.

Each costume company uses their own size chart. We will not know your child's size until costumes have been picked and ordered. All individual classes will be billed \$49 per costume, and combo classes will be billed \$87. Extra fees will be due on February 10th if your child's costume size runs in the x-large child - large adult range.

Costumes are always age-appropriate and of the highest quality possible. To keep the cost down, the costumes are ordered from catalogs and not custom made for each dancer. Therefore; pants, straps, and sleeves may be too long and will need adjustment for each individual child. All alterations will be done through us.

All balances must be taken care of before taking your costume home. You may check your balance online through the parent portal at any time.

All students will purchase a new pair of tights through All-Star Dance Academy at \$6/pair. Students in multiple classes may need several pairs of tights (different color requirements). Tight colors will be announced after costumes are ordered (the same time that we will announce the required shoes and shoe colors per routine).

TICKETS

You must have a ticket to gain admission to the recital. Tickets are \$8.00. A separate ticket is required for each Act. The ticket fees are necessary to cover the costs of renting the facility and dressing rooms, stage manager, sound technician, lighting crew, ushers, custodial fees, etc.

Children 2 years and under will not need a ticket - They will be required to sit in a person's lap while in the theater.

To guarantee tickets, each student will pay for 4 tickets with their recital fees. Families that are in multiple acts may purchase 4 tickets per Act with their recital fees (must be approved with Miss Tawny). All additional tickets will be sold on a first come, first serve basis starting May 19th. We do not hold tickets or take orders in advance of this date.

BREAKDOWN OF FEES AND PAYMENT DUE DATES

The recital fees have been divided into 3 payments to help break up the total. You may pay the entire balance by January 13th, or choose to follow the payment plan. It is important that we receive payments NO LATER THAN the following dates to ensure that all items are ordered for your child (costumes, trophies, tickets, etc)

* If your child measures into an "x-large child - large adult" costume you will be billed the extra \$5 per costume (this will be due by February 10th)

* An extra \$6 will be added for any additional tights your child needs (this will be due by February 10th)

Recital Payment Options

(Does not include monthly tuition)

Option #1: Pay In Full

You will not be automatically charged this amount - you will need to notify Miss Tawny ASAP if you choose this option.

Costumes, Tights, Recital Fee & Tickets * - Due January 13th

Option #2: Payment Plan

This is the default option unless you tell us you wish to choose Option #1.

Tights & Recital Fee * - <u>Due February 10th</u>
